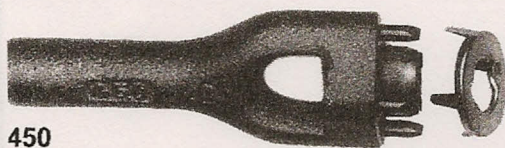

SETTING TOOL FOR COMMON SENSE FASTENERS



T-1619 Prong setting tool with carrying pouch. For installing turn fasteners, twist locks, common sense fasteners or lift-the-dots. Great for bending the four prongs over the washer. This patented tool holds the washer in place and bends the prongs in one operation. Turn the tool over and set all four prongs in one motion. This also works with lift-the-dots and P-2109 & P-2261 Turn Locks. The setting end can also be used to install turn fastener screw bases. The body of the tool is kurl'd "delrim" and all parts are case hardened steel, plated for a life time of use.
